




EXPORT DEVELOPMENT: REGIONAL EXPORT NETWORK (REN)






PENNSYLVANIA: EXPORTS WORLDWIDE

State Trade Expansion Program (STEP) Global Access Program (GAP)

DCED Office of International Business Development (OIBD)



STEP

The **State Trade Expansion Program (STEP)** is a permanent provision of the Small Business Act to make grants to States to carry out projects that help develop exports by eligible companies.

The objective of STEP is to increase:

- 1. the number of U.S. small businesses that export
- 2. the dollar value of exports
- 3. the number of U.S. small businesses exploring significant new trade opportunities





GLOBAL ACCESS PROGRAM (GAP)

The cornerstone of Pennsylvania's STEP program is the **Global Access Program (GAP)**, a financial assistance plan to help SBA-qualified businesses offset their costs of international business development activities.

The GAP grant is managed by DCED's Office of International Business – OIBD.

GAP HIGHLIGHTS

GAP Grant Highlights

- One eligible activity per application
- Up to 2 applications per award year to reach grant maximum, per company
- 75% reimbursement of total eligible expenses. 25% match.
- Two rounds of federal funding available concurrently, both expiring 9/29/21

GAP ELIGIBLE ACTIVITIES

Eligible expenses

include, but are not limited to:

- Virtual tradeshows & mission registration fees
- Compliance testing *
 including: CEE, GDPR, UL Canada, ATEX Testing / Certification, Japan Haz/Loc Certification, IECex
 Testing / Certification, ISO, FSC
- Website internationalization
 - Design & development of website, with an international focus
 - Translation of website


GAP ELIGIBLE ACTIVITIES

- E-Commerce
 - E-Commerce platform fees, including hosting and/or maintenance fees
 - Online market listing fees
 - Expenses for setting up website to accept international payments
- Digital & Marketing Media *
 (design and/or translation of any digital advertising or marketing media, including audio/video and social media, with an international focus)
- U.S. Department of Commerce services, fees and/or any Federal service that directly supports exporting https://www.trade.gov/export-solutions
- International Travel
 - Overseas trade missions
 - Overseas tradeshow exhibition
 - Foreign market sales trips

- Step 3 GAP Application
 - GAP Application
 - -Travel form (if necessary)
 - Domestic Trade Show Form (if necessary)
- Step 4 Review / Approval





- Step 5 Activity occurs
- <u>Step 6</u> Reimbursement & Follow-Up
 - Reimbursement form
 - Receipts, invoices, applicable conversions
 - Post-activity Survey
 - Domestic Trade Show follow-up (if necessary)
- Step 7 Report Export Sales





TIPS AND TRICKS

- Ask questions
- SBA qualification can be done in advance
- Vendor # needed for processing reimbursement
- Project Description Focus on the international component of the activity
- Receipts organize, conversions, make notes as needed
- Report back
