### METROACTION, INC.

MetroAction is the small business affiliate for The Chamber. It provides microloans to small businesses, as well as financing, training, and counseling services.

Skills in Scranton works with educational institutions of all levels and local employers to facilitate career education, talent pipeline development, and workforce development resources.

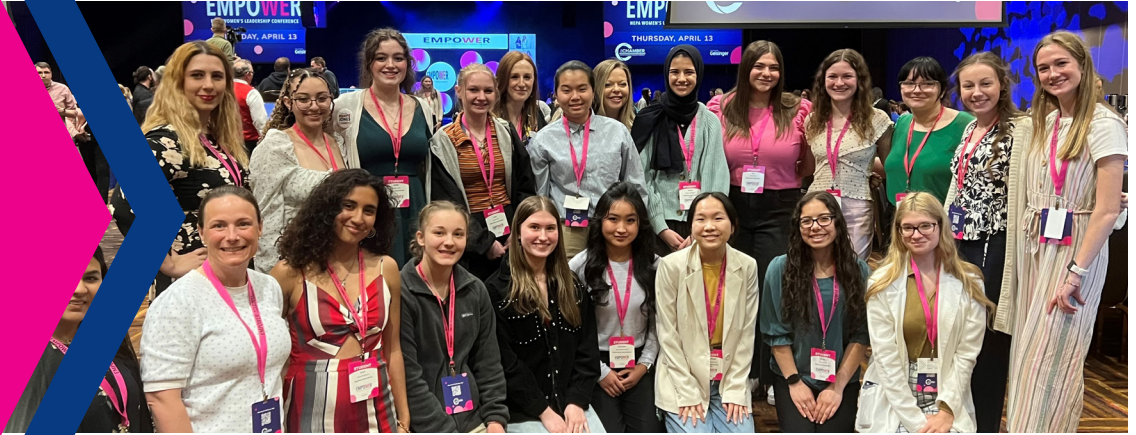
