



Arc Flash / NFPA 70E Training

NEPIRC's Arc Flash / NFPA 70E training is intended for all manufacturing employees and provides an overview of the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) standard for Electrical Safety Requirements for Employee Workplaces (NFPA 70E). OSHA establishes these requirements, and the NFPA 70E provides the solutions to implement these requirements. The Arc Flash / NFPA 70E training will be held on **Wednesday, April 3 from 8 a.m. to noon** at NEPIRC's Hanover Twp. office.
