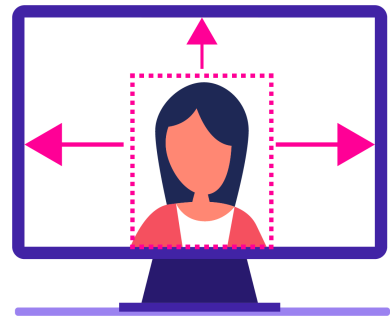
Pro-tips for recording your video:

Camera Settings

We recommend recording at 4k resolution and 30 fps (30 fps is the default setting on an iPhone). If those options are unavailable, select the highest resolution that is, with a minimum of 1080. If your device cannot shoot 1080 footage, please find an alternative device! If you have an iPhone, [this will explain how to change your video settings](#). If you are using an Android phone, changing those settings will depend on the make/model.

Camera Placement

- Hold your phone horizontally when you film so we don't have to artificially zoom in on your footage when we assemble the final product.
- If you are using a computer, place your computer on a solid surface at eye level. Adjust the height of your computer with books or boxes underneath it if necessary. Your head should match the position of the graphic here.



Location

- Find a place with no distractions. There should be no background noise.
- Keep your background simple, like a solid color wall.
- Do not sit in front of a bright light source such as a window, this causes a blown-out effect on camera and we won't be able to see your face. It is better to have light in front of you, not behind you.

Keep in Mind

- There's no need to get anything perfect on the first try. Pause when you need to and don't be afraid of repeating yourself.
- Remember to relax and smile.
