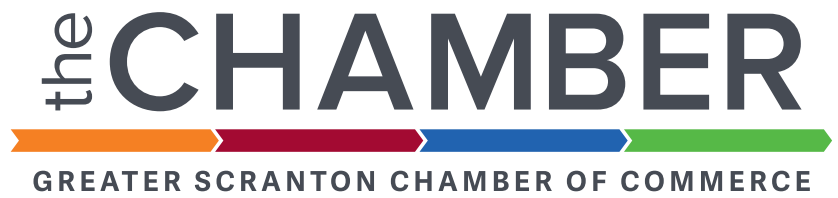

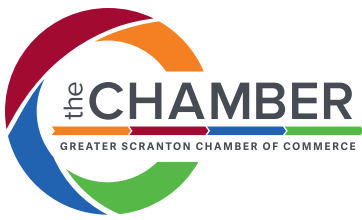

Leadership and Workforce Development Divisions



Leadership Lackawanna | Leadership Development

Leadership Lackawanna provides community leadership training and professional development through programs tailored to high school and college students, young professionals, executives, and more. These programs strengthen participants' skills, connections, and knowledge, enabling them to serve more effectively as community leaders.



Skills in Scranton | Workforce Development

Skills in Scranton collaborates with educational institutions and employers to advance career education, building talent pipelines, and strengthen workforce development resources.

Business and Economic Development Divisions



Lackawanna Industrial Fund Enterprise

LIFE is a business development division of The Chamber, often referred to as our "community bank." Funds originally raised throughout the community continue to be reinvested in projects that foster economic growth.



Scranton Lackawanna Industrial Building Company

SLIBCO serves as The Chamber's business and economic development division. It developed multi-tenant buildings, industrial sites, and office parks in northeastern Pennsylvania, and owns and/or manages three incubator facilities that support start-up and expanding small businesses.



The Scranton Plan

The Scranton Plan is The Chamber's business development marketing program. It assists companies with relocation or expansion by connecting them to available real estate, financial incentives, and access to public and private resources.



IGNITE Program

IGNITE is The Chamber's entrepreneurship and business incubation program. It supports aspiring local business owners through education, counseling, networking, and mentorship.

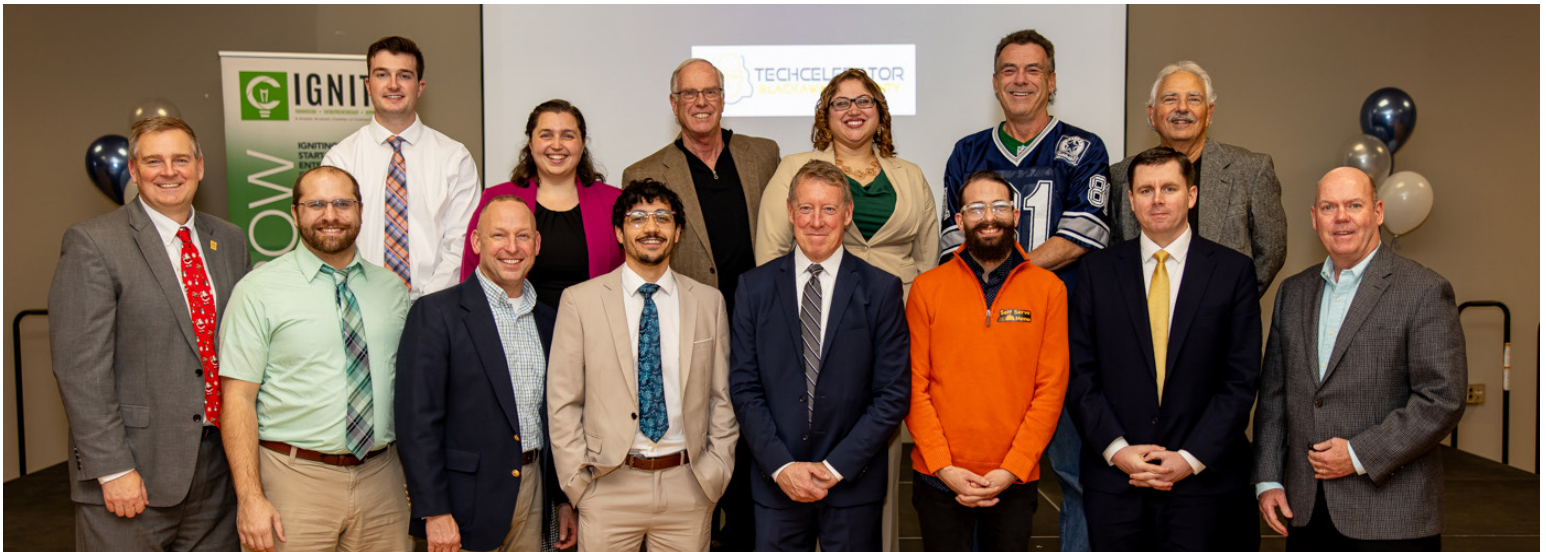
